Insurance Cover

All AOEC Trust Courses are covered by our Public Liability Insurance.

Liability Insurance

Personal Belongings

AOEC Trust is not covered for the loss of personal belongings of staff or young people. Please do not bring large quantities of cash etc. We offer access to our souvenir shop (at the teacher's discretion) where we request a max spend of £5 per child.

Personal Accident Insurance

Clients are not covered for personal accident. This personal insurance is a matter for the individual, or parents/guardians of the individuals concerned.

Safety Statement

AOEC Trust Directors, Management, and Staff accept fully their responsibilities towards their clients and take every reasonable measure to look after their safety and well being. However "living" is not risk free and 100% safety does not exist, but compared to accidents in the home, in the workplace or on the road, the outdoor education industry is NOT considered to be a high safety risk.

Because of the nature of the activities minor injury, such that might be sustained by a child at play or a young person engaging in a sport, (a bump, a bruise or a minor fracture), is possible although unlikely. Similarly exposure to the elements can cause some relative, short-term discomfort. All of these things need to be considered and accepted by course participants.

Participants/parents can be assured that good practice is followed by professional staff competent to do so.
